NEWS RELEASE

FBI Agents arrested today a resident of St. Louis County, Missouri, on a charge of Attempted Sabotage in connection with the burning of the Air Force ROTC Building at Washington University on May 5, 1970.

Mr. J. Wallace LaPrade, Special Agent in Charge, Federal Bureau of Investigation, St. Louis, Missouri, announced the arrest today of Joseph William Eisenberg, age 20, a resident of St. Louis County, Missouri. The arrest of Eisenberg was made following extensive investigation conducted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and is based on an indictment returned by a Federal Grand Jury in St. Louis, Missouri, on July 23, 1970, charging him with violation of Title 18, Section 2153a, pertaining to attempted sabotage of the Air Force ROTC Building at Washington University.

Eisenberg will be afforded an appearance before United States Commissioner Garnet W. Taylor at St. Louis, Missouri promptly.
