SUPPLY BUILDING AT REAR OF AF BUILDING SLIGHTLY DAMAGED, TWO CAMPUS SECURITY OFFICERS INJURED BY ROCKS, NO ARRESTS MADE. CAMPUS AREA QUIET AS OF TWO THIRTY AM.
