

5 men, 2 women held in fatal bombing

Cleveland police yesterday arrested five men and two women for questioning in the bombing of a four-family house late Tuesday night in which three persons were killed and three injured critically.

Six of those arrested are friends of William J. Sigley, 22, of 6101 Lansing Ave. SE, in whose apartment the bomb exploded shortly before midnight Tuesday.

Sigley was not home at the time. His wife, Mary Ann, 21, and son, Christopher Michael, 2, were killed, along with a friend, Burdell M. Offutt, 22, of

8903 Union Ave. SE, who was visiting.

The injured, Sigley's other son, Steven, 9 months, and John, 21, and Deborah Slepko, 16, of 2142 Thurman St. SW, remained in critical

condition in the burn unit of Cleveland Metropolitan General Hospital. Investigators are trying to learn what explosive was used. They said it exploded with the force of a dynamite bomb.
